# Regional Champion

- Implementing TOA RA and further roll out ROB
- SPOC between region & Project Team
- Bringing forward issues, concerns, risks which would affect the implementation of the project **within timescales set by ministers**
- Supporting the training providers



# Road to Implementation

- 4 towns, 4 DATS, 7 Custody suites, 1 PSA
- All ROB
- Early Stakeholders meetings ( Sept)
- Set Regional Targets (Aspirations) for assessment
- Consistent approach to Breach and FTA
- Pre ROB “ Go Live “ ensured  
Accommodation issues resolved





# Challenges

- Secured “ buy in “ from Partners at appropriate level
- Identify key Players
- Requested TOA sub groups from all DIPs
- Frequency of meetings & GO attendance
- Action plan Log of issues
- Support & challenge workforce bids

# Early findings

- Major challenge in education of staff and training new staff, - all 4 sites
- Case Progression role crucial
- CPS & Court links still need to be strengthened
- All sites retained TOA sub groups for next 1/4





# Early findings

- Little Impact yet on Tier 3 treatment services ; however:-
- More Tier 2 capacity envisaged eg pre engagement work
- Changing Data Manager role sites need to build in resilience to cope
- Very skewed compact targets unable to reconcile, nationally still on charge





# Early Data

- % +ve tests increased approx 45% , 49% in 1 site
- FTA as much as 50% drop out , appointments out of custody . Site with maximum custody coverage achieved 33%
- No significant impact on refusals of test
- 12 RA refused in custody - All charged





# Early Data

- 33 new clients taken onto Caseload , underwent RA but were not subsequently charged with offence or on 47 (3)
- DM's are looking at Caseload Impact
- -formula 3 months prior to TC, total new to caseload ( average) compared with Dec, Jan, Feb to obtain % increase
